
Calcutta Chapter

- * Started on <u>08 October, 1997</u> with just 20 members
- Only independent IAS Chapter (not a joint Chapter) in India till 2005

AS Calcutta Chapter



- *The city of Calcutta (now renamed 'Kolkata'), is located in the eastern part of India, was established by the East India Company in late 17th Century as a center of trade for the British. During the following centuries of British colonial rule, it had served as the capital of India till the early 20th century (1911)
 - It is located beside the Hooghly river, a part of the sacred Ganges or Ganga and is the center of rich Scientific, Arts and Cultural heritage. All five Nobel prize winners from India had worked in their respective diverse fields in this city.



Glimpses of Kolkata

- Kolkata metropolitan area has a population exceeding 15 million, 3rd most populous metropolitan area in India
- The city is classified as the eighth largest urban agglomeration in the world (area 1,750 km²);City has an area of 185 km²
- Kolkata boasts of Eastern India's only IT hub, its software sector growth transforming it as one of the Hotbeds of Indian IT Industry

History of IEEE—IAS CALCUTTA CHAPTER

- ➤ IAS Calcutta Chapter was officially started on 8th October ,1997 with just about 20 members
- ➤ It is one of the 8 Chapters of IEEE Calcutta Section . Other Chapters are: AP-MTT, COMSOC, Computer, EDS, LEOS, PES, CAS; Website: http://ewh.ieee.org/r10/calcutta/
- ➤ IEEE Calcutta Section started as Eastern Regional Sub-Section in 1971 with members over the entire Eastern and North-Eastern region of India and was elevated to a Section in September 28, 1978. The activities of the Section are spread over many cities and state capitals under this Section with 8 Chapters, two Affinity Groups (GOLD, WIE) and 16 Student Branches
- ➤ IAS members, mainly in the Calcutta region ,took an interest in forming a Chapter to cater to the technical activities of their specific interest and Dr S K Biswas, with encouragement from Dr A K Chattopadhyay and Mr C Satish, (the IAS Region 10 Area Chair) submitted a <u>petition</u> on 15 September,1997 to form an IAS Chapter at Calcutta, which was forwarded by the IEEE Calcutta Section with full co-operation
